
Call for Extensions 2

As the majority of EPIC's second cohort has now mobilised, it was decided to award further extensions with the small amount of remaining budget. Once again this Call was popular with scholars across all host universities and we received a total of 30 applications. The quality was very high and it was very difficult to choose! As the budget available was very small, we awarded 8 of these applicants, all of whom were ranked highly by their hosts and showed good evidence of progression and academic merit to the proposed extension. We wish our scholars all the best and look forward to hearing of the results of their extended mobility!

Current statistics

Out of 214 scholars, 100 have completed and 86 are currently mobilised. We have only 28 scholars yet to mobilise. From our second Cohort, we have only 3 undergraduates and 1 post doctorate scholar yet to mobilise and all are set to begin their mobility by 31st December as per the EACEA regulation. The remaining scholars yet to mobilise are all staff.
