#### January 2015

The Second Call for Applications, open to undergraduate and staff applicants, closes. Applicants are then assessed and selected by the Selection Committee in March.





#### February 2015

After EACEA extends an additional half a million euros funding for Moroccan nationals to the project, a special Call for Applications-Morocco Edition, opens. The call launches at the master, doctorate, post-doctorate, and staff levels. A Road Show is planned to encourage students and scholars across Morocco to apply.

#### March 16-18, 2015

A promotional road show is held across Morocco at the campuses of Cadi Ayyad University in Marrakech, University Hassan I in Settat, University Hassan II in Casablanca, and Mohammed V University in Rabat. University representatives from Sapienza University of Rome, the University of Bordeaux, the University of Zagreb, and the University of Hassan II-Casablanca share information about the programme at multiple sessions and reach between 450-500 students and staff members. The event is very successful, as the call receives the highest number of applicants from Morocco in the history of the project.

Nominees receive notification of their scholarship and start preparing for their upcoming mobility.








After the Selection Committee meeting for Cohort 2, held on the 30th March 2015, the following 33 scholarships were awarded accordingly by level and nationality:


