

BSc (Hons) Complementary Healthcare 2018 Entry

Additional Costs

All programmes of study within Complementary Healthcare have at least one embedded professional qualification. This entails the completion of case studies in students' own time and they will need to invest in some equipment to achieve this. This investment should not be regarded as solely for the purpose of completing the coursework; it will last the duration of the programme and beyond providing the capacity for earning money from newly acquired professional skills.

All the equipment necessary for classwork and the consumable materials required for case studies conducted on the university premises are provided and paid for by the department. Additionally, the department covers the cost of student professional indemnity insurance each year and of student professional body membership where it is a requirement for external body examinations.
